



# הבדלה למצוֹא שבת ויום טוב

## Havdalah after Shabbos and Festivals

**At the departure of a weekday Yom Tov Festival – completely fill a cup with at least 2.9 ounces of wine, take the cup in your right hand, and skip to ... סברִי ...**

**At the departure of Shabbos – light the Havdalah candle, completely fill a cup with at least 2.9 ounces of wine, take the cup in your right hand, take fragrant spices in your left hand, and recite the following paragraph:**

הנה אל ישועתי אבטח ולא אפחד כי עזיז זומרת יה יי ויהי לי לשועה.  
ושאבתם מים בשׁוֹן ממעיני היישועה. לי הי ישועה על עמך ברכתך  
סלחה. יי צבאות עמנו משגב לנו אלהי יעקב סלה. יי צבאות אשרי  
אדם בטח בה. יי הושיעה המלך יעננו ביום קראנו. לייהודים היתה אורה  
ושמחה ושׁוֹן ויקרא. כן תהיה לנו. כוס ישועות אשא ובשם יי אקרא.

Behold! God is my salvation – I shall trust in Him and not fear; for God, THE ETERNAL, is my might and my praise, and He was a salvation for me. You will draw water with joy from the wellsprings of salvation. It is upon THE ETERNAL to save, while it is upon Your people to bless You forever! THE ETERNAL – Master of all the hosts of heaven and earth – is with us; the God of Yaakov (Jacob) is our assurance and inspiration forever. O ETERNAL, Master of legions, praiseworthy is the man who trusts solely in You. O ETERNAL, save us! May the King answer us on the day we call! For the Jews [in the days of Esther and Mordechai] there was light, happiness, joy, and honor – so may it be for us. I will raise the cup of salutations, and I shall invoke the name of THE ETERNAL.

**After Shabbos, continue here; or at the departure of a weekday Yom Tov, begin here:**

**סְבִּרִי מַרְנָנו וּרְבָנָנו וּרְבָוֹתֵינוּ –**

By your leave, my masters and teachers:

**Recite this blessing over the wine (but don't drink it yet):**

**ברוך אתה יי א-להינו מלך העולם, בורא פרי הגפן.**

Blessed are You, O ETERNAL, our God, King of the universe, Who creates the fruit of the vine.

(Amen. אמן. - all present respond)

**For Shabbos departure only (not Yom Tov), place the cup in your left hand and the spices in your right hand, then recite this blessing and smell the spices:**

**ברוך אתה יי א-להינו מלך העולם, בורא מני בשמים.**

Blessed are You, O ETERNAL, our God, King of the universe, Who creates fragrant species.

(Amen. אמן. - all present respond)

**Place the spices on the table for the remainder of Havdalah.**

For Shabbos departure only (not Yom Tov), recite this blessing while seeing the flame of the Havdala candle reflected on your fingernails:

**ברוך אתה ייִשְׁעָרָה קָדוֹשׁ בָּרוּךְ הוּא מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, בָּרוּךְ מֶאֱוֵרִי הַאֲשָׁר.**

Blessed are You, O ETERNAL, our God, King of the universe, Who creates the illumination of the fire.

(Amen. אָמֵן - all present respond)

Return the cup to your right hand and recite this blessing to acknowledge the departure of Shabbos, Yom Tov, or both; then drink the wine.

**ברוך אתה ייִשְׁעָרָה קָדוֹשׁ בָּרוּךְ הוּא מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, הַמְבָדֵיל בֵּין קָדְשׁוֹ לְחֻולָּה, בֵּין  
אוֹר לְחֹשֶׁךְ, בֵּין יִשְׂרָאֵל לְעַמִּים, בֵּין יוֹם הַשְׁבִּיעִי לְשְׁשָׁת יְמֵי  
הַמְּעַשָּׂה. ברוך אתה ייִשְׁעָרָה קָדוֹשׁ בָּרוּךְ הוּא מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם.**

Blessed are You, O ETERNAL, our God, King of the universe, Who separates between holy and ordinary, between light and darkness, between Yisraw-eil (Israel) and the other nations, between the Seventh Day and the the six days of work. Blessed are You, O ETERNAL, Who separates between holy and ordinary.

(Amen. אָמֵן - all present respond)

Those who drank at least 2.9 ounces of wine recite the following after-blessing:

**ברוך אתה ייִשְׁעָרָה קָדוֹשׁ בָּרוּךְ הוּא מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם עַל הַגָּפָן וְעַל פְּרִי הַגָּפָן, וְעַל תְּנוּבָת  
הַשְׁדָּה, וְעַל אֶרֶץ חַמְדָה טוֹבָה וּרְחַבָּה, שְׁرֵצִית וּהַנְּחַלָּת לְאֶבֶוֹתֵינוּ, לְאַכְוֹל מִפְרִיה  
וְלִשְׁבּוֹעַ מִטוּבָה. רְחֵם נָא, ייִשְׁעָרָה קָדוֹשׁ בָּרוּךְ הוּא, וְעַל יְרוּשָׁלָם עִיר  
וְעַל צִיּוֹן מִשְׁכָּנוֹ כְּבוֹדָה, וְעַל מִזְבֵּחָה, וְעַל הַיכְלָה. וּבְנָה יְרוּשָׁלָם עִיר קָדְשָׁה  
בְּמִהְרָה בְּיָמֵינוּ, וְהַעֲלָנוּ לְתֹוכָה, וְשִׁמְחָנוּ בְּבִנִינָה, וְנַאכְל מִפְרִיה וְנַשְׁבַּע מִטוּבָה,  
וְנִבְרַכְךָ עַלְיהָ בְּקָדְשָׁה וּבְתְּהָרָה. [Rosh Chodesh] - וְזִכְרָנוּ לְטוֹבָה, בַּיּוֹם רָאשׁ הַחֲדָשׁ הַזֶּה.  
[Sukkos Chol Hamoed] - וְשִׁמְחָנוּ בַּיּוֹם חַג הַמְצֹות הַזֶּה. \ Sukkos Chol Hamoed  
בַּיּוֹם חַג הַסְּכּוֹת הַזֶּה. [C] כי אתה ייִשְׁעָרָה קָדוֹשׁ בָּרוּךְ הוּא לְכָל, וְנוֹזֵה לְה עַל הָאָרֶץ וְעַל פְּרִי  
הַגָּפָן. ברוך אתה ייִשְׁעָרָה קָדוֹשׁ בָּרוּךְ הוּא גַּפְנָה גַּפְנָה (If the wine was from Israel, use instead)**

Blessed are You, O ETERNAL, our God, King of the universe, for the vine and its fruit; And for the produce of the field, for the beautiful and spacious land which You gave to our ancestors as a heritage to eat of its fruit and to enjoy its goodness. Have mercy, O ETERNAL our God, on Israel Your people, on Jerusalem Your city, on Tziyon the abode of Your glory, on Your altar and Your Temple. Rebuild Jerusalem, the holy city, speedily in our days. Bring us there and cheer us with its restoration; may we eat of its fruit and enjoy of its goodness; may we bless You for it in holiness and purity.

[Rosh Chodesh] - And remember us for goodness on this Rosh Chodesh / Sukkos Chol Hamoed - And gladden us on this festival of Matzos / Sukkos Chol Hamoed - And gladden us on this festival of Sukkos For You, O ETERNAL are good and beneficent to all, and we thank You for the land and the fruit of the vine. Blessed are You, O ETERNAL, for the land and the fruit of the vine.
